

South Liverpool Domestic Abuse Services Ltd is recruiting for a **Projects & Engagement Worker**, a new post to provide access to a full range of SLDAS services for women from marginalised communities in South Liverpool, through the delivery of outreach sessions in discreet local venues.

Working with SLDAS staff and trained volunteers, this role requires an understanding of the barriers that women from all communities face when domestic abuse is an issue, as well as the barriers that women from Black & minoritised communities experience when seeking support services.

We are looking for a woman with an imaginative and enthusiastic approach to developing the organisation's work, a clear commitment to overcoming barriers and delivering equality, diversity and inclusion; and who is passionate about ending violence against all women & girls.

Women from Black & minoritised communities and women with lived experience are encouraged to apply.

The Projects & Engagement Worker post will be full time 37 hours per week, funded to June 2023 by the Ellie Trust, also with support from PH Holt Foundation. SLDAS aims for outreach work to continue, subject to funding.
